The College believes in the value of homework. Students are encouraged right from the start to expect tasks set to be completed at home, though the nature of the task will differ. Some will consist of written tasks, others will involve research or learning of materials. On occasions, homework may be planning activities or collecting information.

40 minutes per subject will be expected in Year 7 ,8,& 9. For older students homework will usually be two or three subjects a night - 50 minutes per subject in Years 10 and 11.

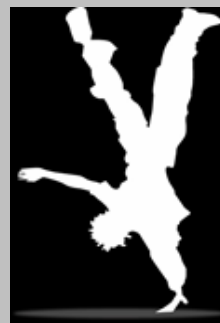
